The [Detroit Women's Chorus](#) invites submissions of sample works for voice from emerging composers. We encourage submissions from all composers regardless of their level of formal training. There is no entrance fee.

The Winner will receive:

- A commission to compose a work for the Detroit Women's Chorus that is consistent with our mission and vision
- Contract of \$500
- A mentorship session with Detroit-based singer, multi-instrumentalist, and composer [Shara Nova](#)
- Premiere of the winner's commissioned work at the Spring 2022 Detroit Women's Chorus Concert (or the first live performance scheduled after Covid-19 restrictions are lifted)

Requirements:

- The submitted sample work(s) must be original (up to two may be submitted)
- The submission may be in the form of an audio or video recording, a written score, or a combination
- Composers must be US residents
